NACE Annual Golf Tourney Once again a sellout!

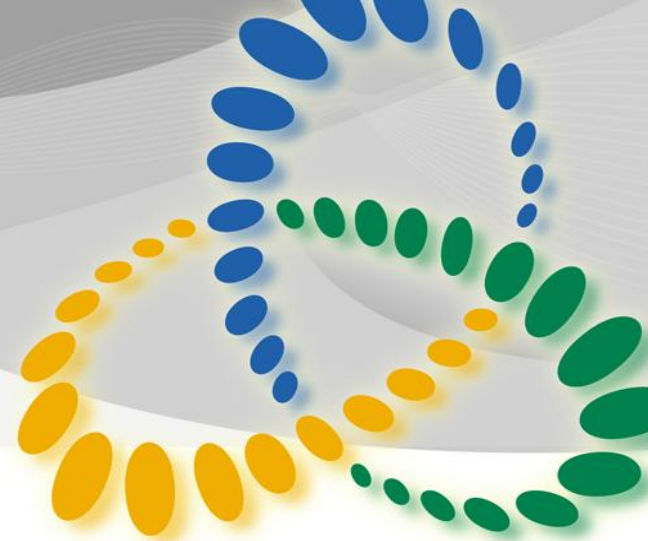
This year's golf tournament on August 17 was another sold out event, with 216 golfers making up 54 foursomes on a beautiful sunny day in mid August.
