Overview of NACE Experiences and Student Poster Project (Stress Corrosion Cracking)

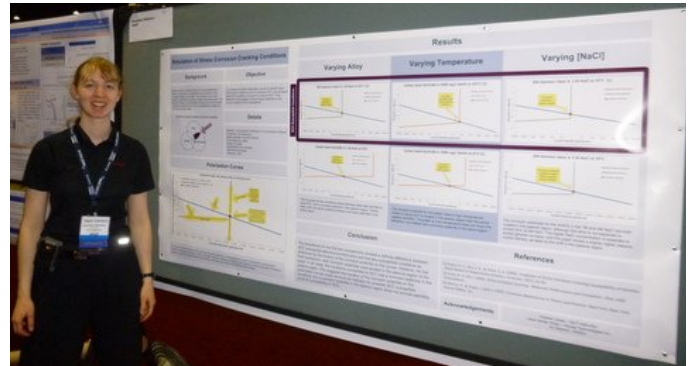
Thanks to the presenters, the 10 industry professionals who came to network with the students, and to Jana Johnson, Membership Chair, for organizing this popular event.
