NACE Calgary donated \$1000 profits from the Coatings trade show towards Tim Whitten's participation in the Sears National Kids Cancer Ride. The donation was made in the name of Dave Scott, a NACE member who recently passed away after a battle with cancer. Dave was heavily involved with the NACE Calgary section in previous years through various committee roles and organization of the Calgary chapters annual golf tournament for a number of years.

On June 13, 2009, Tim and 35 other selected National Riders started the 12-day, 7,000 km trans-Canada odyssey from Vancouver to Halifax. NACE Calgary supported David Richardson, P.Eng. of QM4 Engineering Ltd. as a speaker at the GPAC Annual Operation and Maintenance Conference in May.


The conference began 21 years ago to provide value to the membership, with a focus on field operations. Consistent with the theme, David presented a well-received technical paper highlighting how the spatial representation of pipeline data, as well as associated operational, inspection, and monitoring data, provides the opportunity to better identify patterns of corrosion activity and contributing factors.

The enhanced data visualization and assessment provided by spatial data technology positions the owners with a 'systems understanding', and the ability to adopt a forward-looking pipeline integrity management program as an alternative to continuing with a reactive business environment. The cost savings benefits of a systems-approach were well characterized in the presentation.
